

FCC Part 15 Testing Checklist

The following is a list of items Compliance Worldwide will need to complete your testing and application preparation for the FCC Part 15 filing of your product.

- Two pieces of equipment (transmitter and associated receiver) with operational software to achieve the necessary states for testing. Typical states are continuous transmit, continuous receive.
- All power supplies, cables and any other peripheral equipment need to operate and/or configure the product
- Your company's federal tax identification number for the FCC Form 159.
- If the manufacturer is different than the applicant then the company name, city and country that the product is made in.
- A check made out to the Federal Communications Commission, 445 12th Street SW, Washington DC 20554, for \$985.00 (US dollars) **or** mastercard / visa number holder's name and expiration date. Add \$45.00 USD for new company (never part 15 certified) and \$145.00 USD for requests of confidentiality. One check for the total amount is required, separate checks will not be accepted.

DOCUMENTATION NEEDS TO BE PROVIDED IN ONE OF THE FOLLOWING ELECTRONIC FORMATS (Acrobat – PDF, Microsoft Word, and/or JPG (picture format))

- Any marketing literature for the product if available
- A users / operators manual for the product
- A set of schematics for the product
- A parts list / build of materials for the product
- Block diagram of the major portions of the product
- A circuit description of the product and how it operates
- An agency agreement on your company letterhead that allows us to file the FCC Part 15 Application on your behalf. (we will send you an example of this)
- If requested, a letter asking the commission for confidentiality for the technical portions of your application.
